Having spawned many different subgenres every member of the TRAIN YARD KINGS is infusing his own style resulting in a unique blend of authentic 50s bops, Neo-Rockabilly tunes as well as Jive, Jump Blues and Revival songs. From Doo-Wop to Swing and Country performances include songs by Louis Jordan, The Drifters, Lee Rocker, Brian Setzer, Billy Lee Riley, Chris Isaak and Elvis.

Having no regular lead, you'll find that all five musicians perform selected songs resulting in a change of pace and a few surprises at every show. Even the first bars of a song alone will convince you of their love for music. Songs are not simply covered but carefully arranged and played with great joy. Their passion will sweep you away and won't allow you to sit still because this music is made to dance.
